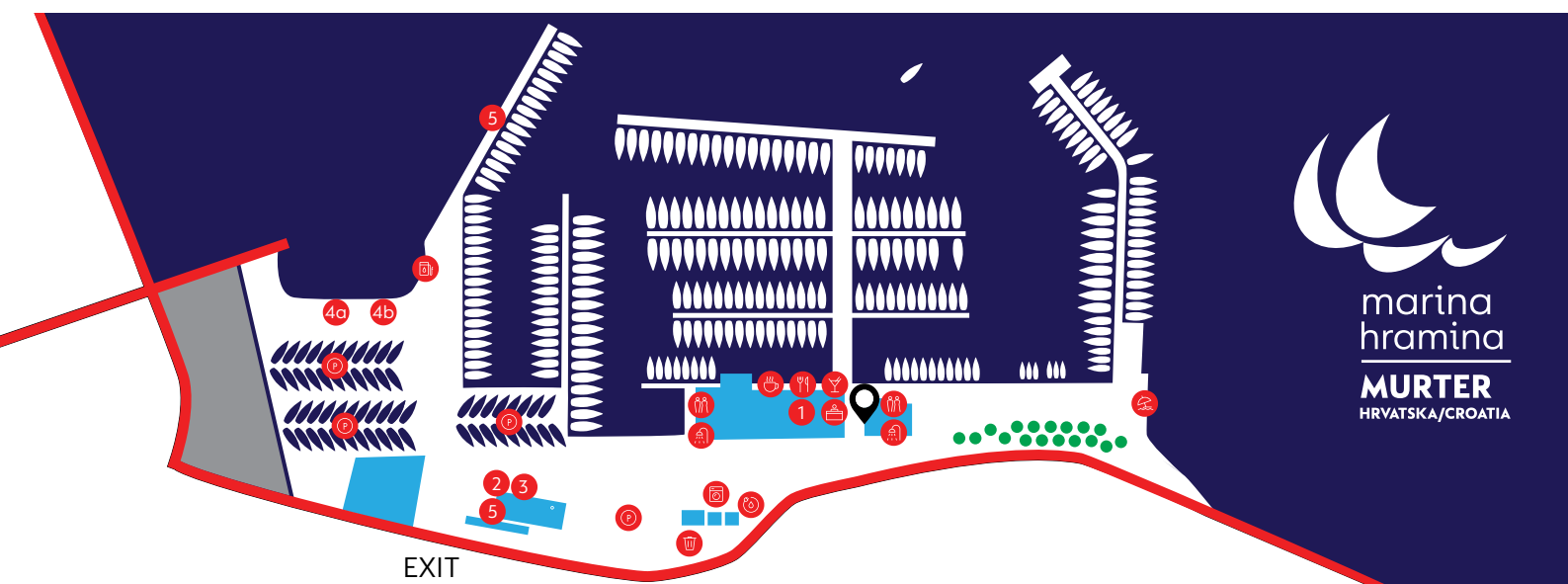

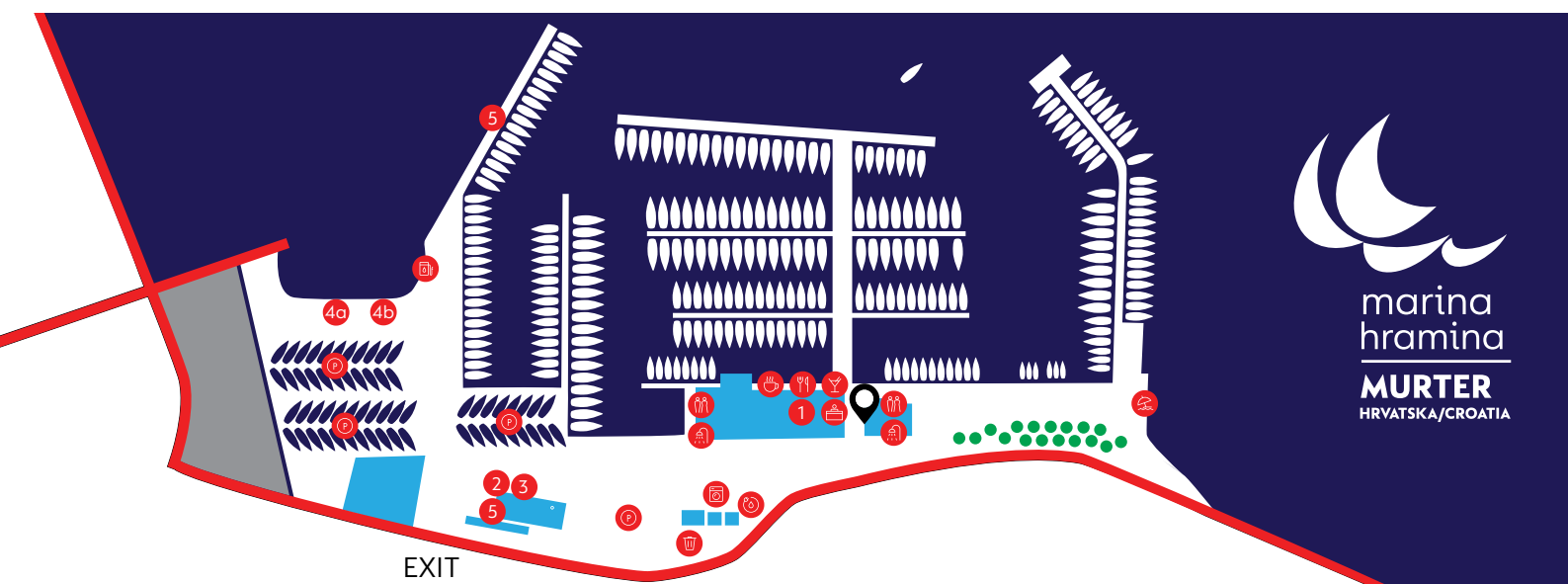

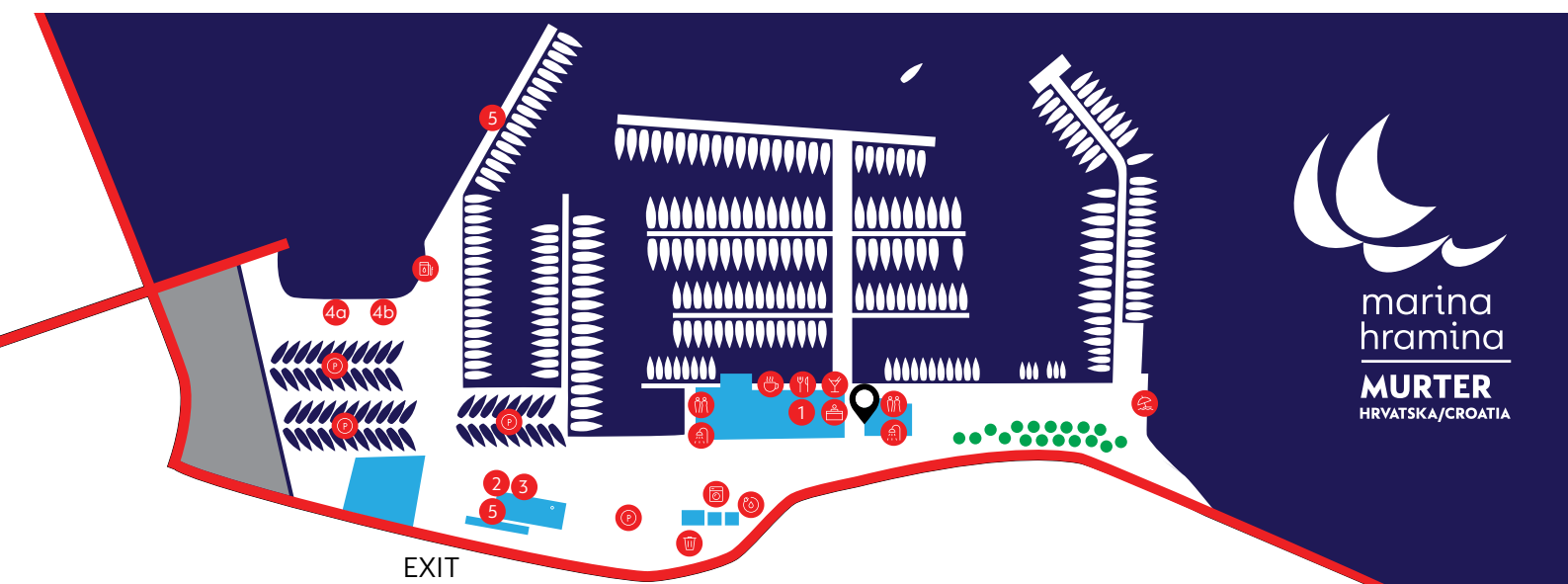

LOCAL CUISINE

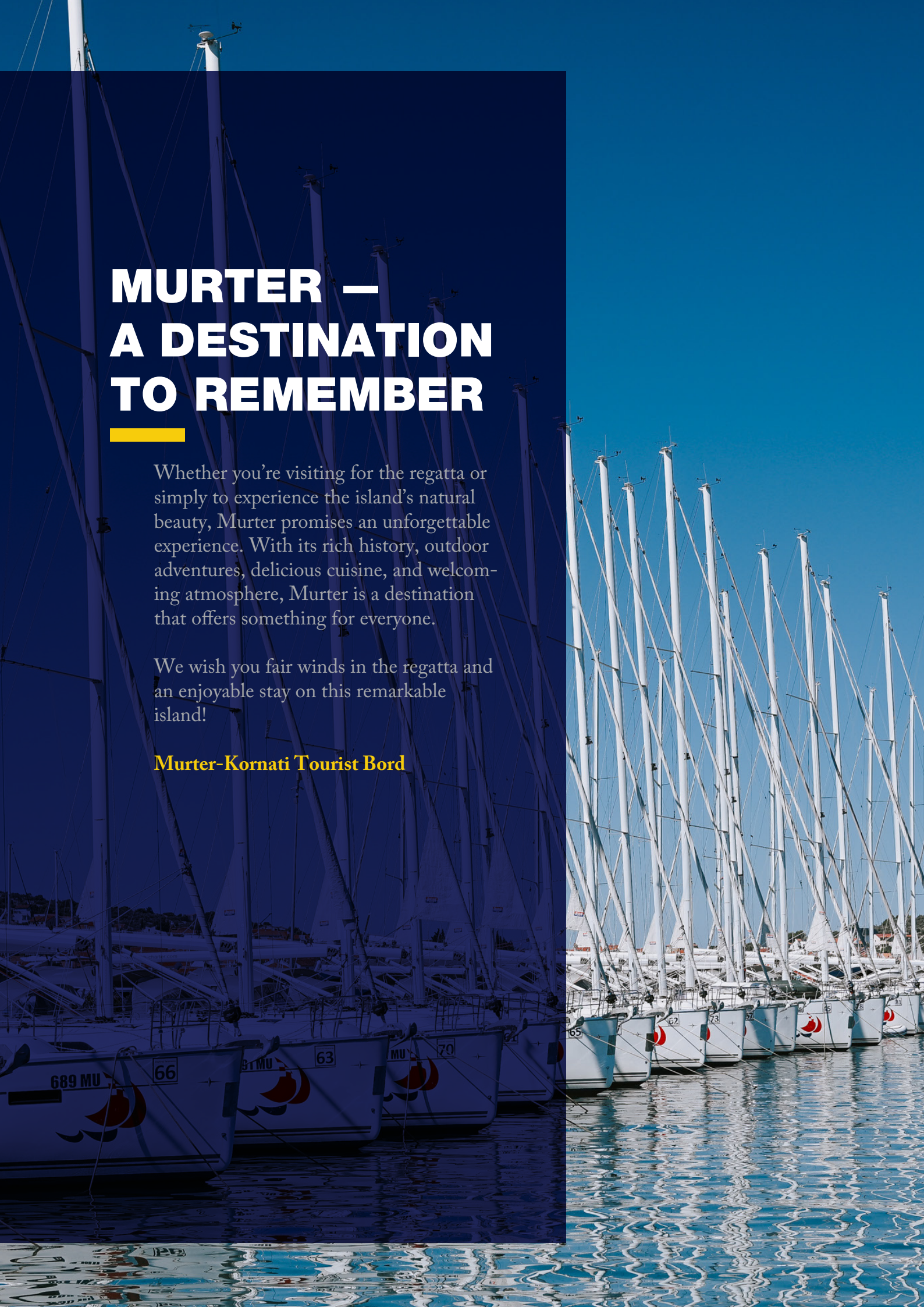

LIONS VINEYARDS OF KINDNESS



„Lions Vineyard of Kindness“ is located in the heart of Vukovo vineyards in the Srijem wine-growing region, not far from the center of Ilok, the easternmost Croatian town.

Ilok's unique terroir, climate and location on the Danube River, suitable for winegrowing, was recognized way back in history, during ancient Greek and Roman times, continuing into Middle Ages and the modern period.

The first written traces of winegrowing in this area date back to the Illyrian period and in the 17th century the Odescalchi family puts a striking mark in the process of creating great wines, modernizing their cellars and for the first time in Europe marks the bottles with family seal thus designating extraordinary quality and original domain filling.

New wine-growing and winemaking trends were introduced after building the new Ilok Cellars (Iločki podrumi).

Ilok Cellars are guardians of Croatian wine tradition. Special expert attention awarded to elegant unique wines reflects the power of the mighty Danube and the unique terroirs of Principovac and Vukovo.

The quality, originality and elegance of these wines is confirmed by platinum, gold, silver and bronze of the most influential wine authorities.

The Ilok Cellars premium wine was served at the celebration of the coronation of Queen Elizabeth II and at other royal wedding ceremonies.

GOALS



Guided by the principle of kindness, the promotion of environmental awareness and the importance of gaining knowledge as fundamental values of our organization, this project, realized through the cooperation of Lions Club Zrinjevac Zagreb, District 126 Croatia and Iločki podrumi d.o.o.
